Please **do not ignore** this email if you were a Spring 2025-26 **expected** candidate for graduation who, for some reason, ended up not completing your graduation requirements, yet still would like to march in the ceremony. The submitted online application for graduation for Spring 2025-26 **does not** confirm your eligibility to participate in the commencement exercises. You must complete the online petition by the set deadline and meet the stated requirements.

We hope this email finds you well. As the academic year draws to a close, we would like to extend an invitation to potential Summer 2025-26 candidates for graduation (expected to complete your graduation requirements by the beginning of August 2026) to apply to participate in the 2026 Commencement Exercises if you meet the following specific requirements:

- 1. The courses you still require range between 0 credits and 3 credits, and**
- 2. You register for these remaining credits in summer\***

You must submit an online petition form using OPFS. The name of the petition form is "Intention to March in the Commencement Ceremony."

Petitions from interested students must reach the Office of the Registrar by May 11, 2026, at the latest. We regret that no exceptions will be made for late submissions, so make all efforts to ensure that you submit your petition on time.

**\*It is mandatory to include the course you wish to register for in the petition. If you have not already registered for the course, the registration team will be informed to do so on your behalf.** OSB students who are missing only the internship requirement must submit the petition but will not be registered until the drop/add period of Summer 2025-26.

The Commencement Exercise is a momentous occasion in the life of every student, and we are making immense efforts to keep it as planned despite all the challenges. We hope that you will join us in celebrating this important milestone. We look forward to congratulating you on your achievements and welcoming you as an alumna or alumnus of AUB.
