Dear AUB Students,

This is a friendly reminder that academic advising for continuing students for the Summer 2025-26 and Fall 2026-27 terms will begin on April 7 and run until April 9, 2026.

Course registration for the Summer 2025-26 term will be open from April 14 to April 16, 2026.

New Three-Phase Registration Mechanism for Fall 2026-27.

To enhance flexibility and provide more opportunities for students to complete their registration efficiently after seeking advising, course registration for the Fall 2026-27 term will now take place in three phases:

- **Phase I:** April 22, 23, 24, 27, and 28, 2026
- **Phase II:** June 9, 10, and 11, 2026
- **Phase III:** August 11, 12, and 13, 2026

Please note that registration time tickets are generated and can be viewed on AUBsis or by accessing the [Summer 2025-26 Registration Guide](#) or [Fall 2026-27 Registration Guide](#) on the [Office of the Registrar](#) webpage. These tickets will open and close daily at the same time, throughout the registration period.

Alternate PINs for registration are generated for students who require them and can be obtained from your academic advisor(s), **with unique pins issued for each term.**

Please note that registering for a course during this period is a prerequisite for making any subsequent changes to your schedule during the drop and add period. Therefore, we strongly encourage you to take immediate action and ensure your registration is completed before the deadline.

Important Alerts.

Kindly remember that registering for courses for any purpose other than your own program completion is a violation of the student code of conduct and will be referred for disciplinary action.

Furthermore, automating course registration through scripts, bots, or programs generates an excessive number of system requests, leading to system resource exhaustion and degraded performance, which violates system integrity policies and is

strictly prohibited. Any attempts to manipulate the registration system in this manner will be considered an abuse of university resources and may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to the cancellation of course registrations, restriction of system access, and referral to the appropriate University conduct committee.
