Dear AUB Students,

We hope you are doing well as the semester winds towards its close and you look forward to the start of reading period on Tuesday.

In light of the war and difficulties experienced by the university community because of it, we are writing to inform you of the university's decision to apply institutional scholarship and probation financial aid amnesty to the spring 2025-26 term on an exceptional basis.

This means the following: (i) the university will not enforce the minimum term GPA required to keep institutional scholarships, such as the early merit or President's merit scholarships, and (ii) although the university will calculate and implement academic standing (probation), students will not lose their financial aid based on their academic standing in accordance with the procedures with respect to grace terms.

That is, if a student has already benefited from a grace term and falls below the required term GPA or finds herself or himself on probation for a second time or more, the spring 2025-26 term will count as another grace term in the university's calculations of financial consequences.

Please note that this exception applies only to financial aid and scholarship implications; all academic consequences, including those related to removal of probation, continuous probation, and dismissal, will continue to be applied in accordance with existing university policies.
