## **Biography**

Amira Marzouk is the executive director of the Center for Democracy for All, and former member of the Tunisian National Constituent Assembly. She was elected to the Pan African Parliament, and also served on the Human Rights Commission.

Amira studied law, gender studies, and political sciences while also serving on the African Union's investigation committee in Sudan and South Sudan and as a member of the African Union's election observation mission in various African countries. From 2012 to 2014, she was Tunisia's only female representative to the Pan African Parliament and its board. She also served as the ambassador of the World Forum of Women Parliamentarians.

Amira is an alumna of the MEPI Leaders of Democracy Fellowship Program at the American University of Beirut in 2016, and the International Visitors Leadership Program in the United States in 2015.

Over the years, she participated in the work to pass legislation to promote women's rights, women's political participation, and gender equality in access to all levels of responsibility and in all domains.
