Beirut, Lebanon- 19/05/2015 - The Munib and Angela Masri Institute of Energy and Natural Resources (Masri Institute) at AUB is hosting its 5th International Workshop on Friday, May 22, 2015 from 8:30 a.m. till 2 pm, in College Hall, Auditorium B1. The workshop is titled: “Emerging Energy Scenarios in the Middle East: Challenges and Implications” and it will bring together academics, energy experts and policy makers to thoroughly assess the different energy pathways proposed for the region. The workshop also aims to establish a Middle East energy network to promote research, outreach activities and connectivity among energy experts.
