AUB raises the flag for Lebanon

The American University of Beirut (AUB) community gathered in front of West Hall on November 21, 2017, in an annual ceremony to raise the national flag in honor of Lebanese Flag Day, a day before Lebanon's Independence Day.

Dean of Student Affairs Talal Nezameddin, Associate Dean of Student Affairs, Dr. Charbel Tarraf, faculty, staff, and students participated in the ceremony, which started with the Lebanese national anthem.

Speaking about the ceremony, Dr. Talal Nezameddin said, "Whatever the weather, rain or shine, we gather here to honor the Lebanese flag and once more express and dedicate our loyalty to our beautiful Lebanon."

He then talked about the student elections that happened recently at AUB saying, "Here at AUB the student body elected its representatives in free, fair, and innovative elections to prove that Lebanon can be a role model for the region and that AUB is a role model for Lebanon." He stated that this achievement is a credit to the AUB community and students in particular, who handled themselves in a civilized way before, during, and after the elections.
