

Amira Marzouk Biography

Amira Marzouk, is the executive director of the Center Democracy for All, and a former parliament member of the Tunisian National Constituent Assembly. She was elected as a member of the Pan African Parliament and served as a member of the Human Rights Commission.

In addition to studying law, gender studies, and political sciences, Amira worked within the investigation committee within Sudan and South Sudan with the African Union and was a member of the observation election mission in different countries in Africa. She was Tunisia's only female representative to the Pan African Parliament and its board from 2012 to 2014. She also served as the ambassador of the World Forum of Women Parliamentarians.

Amira is an alumna of the MEPI Leaders of Democracy Fellowship Program at the American University of Beirut in 2016 and the International Visitors Leadership Program in the USA in 2015.

Over the years, she participated to pass legislation to promote women's rights, women's political participation, and equal opportunities between women and men in access to all levels of responsibility and in all domains.
